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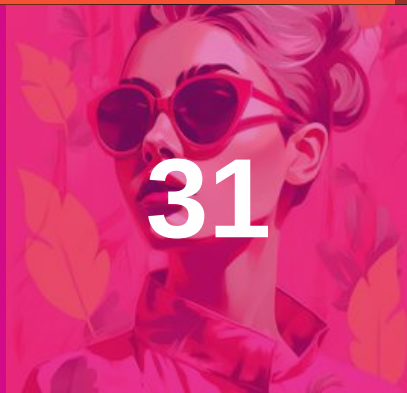

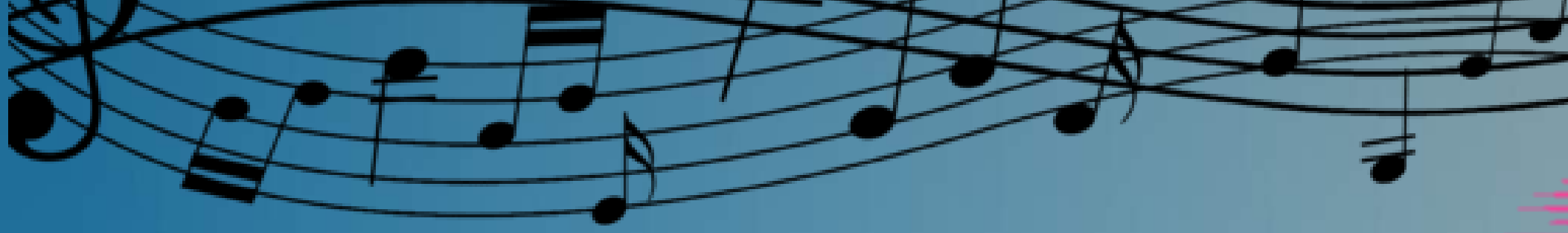

SOLO SINGING

SOLO EVENT

Amity University's Amiphoria hosts a mesmerizing unplugged solo: a lone artist, spotlight embracing, crafts an acoustic symphony. Each note resonates in the vibrant atmosphere, weaving a musical tapestry that unites the Amity community in shared euphoria. A harmonious blend of talent and spirit, igniting the essence of Amiphoria's celebration.

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Time: 6mins (1min Sound check,5min Performance)

RULES:

- A singer can only accompany their vocals with either one instrument or a Electric tanpura.
- Participants are prohibited from using electronic devices, including MIDI equipments and VST plugins.
- As this is a solo performance, only one participant is permitted to perform.
- Singing inappropriate or profane songs with vulgar language is prohibited.
- In the event of any uncommon circumstances, the judge's ruling stands as ultimate.
- It is strictly forbidden to view lyrics while singing.
- The registration fee for each participant is ₹200.
- The registration fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.
- Participants who are not selected cannot request a refund of their registration fee.





WAR OF BANDS TEAM EVENT

Amity University's Amiphoria hosts a fierce musical clash as bands duel with amplified guitars, thunderous drums, and commanding vocals. The stage transforms into an arena of sonic warfare, where melodies collide and rhythms clash, captivating the Amity community in a dynamic battle of musical prowess. 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Number of Participants

- **Maximum Participants: 7**
- **Minimum Participants: 4**

Time: 15mins (3mins Sound Check, 12mins Performance)

RULES:

- A drum set will be provided, however, you'll need to bring your own cymbals.
- Participants are prohibited from using midi equipment's and vst plugins.
- Singing inappropriate or profane songs with vulgar language is prohibited.
- The language of the chosen song poses no barrier.
- In the event of any uncommon circumstances, the judge's ruling stands as ultimate.
- Registration Fee – Rs.1000
- Registration fee will be not refundable.

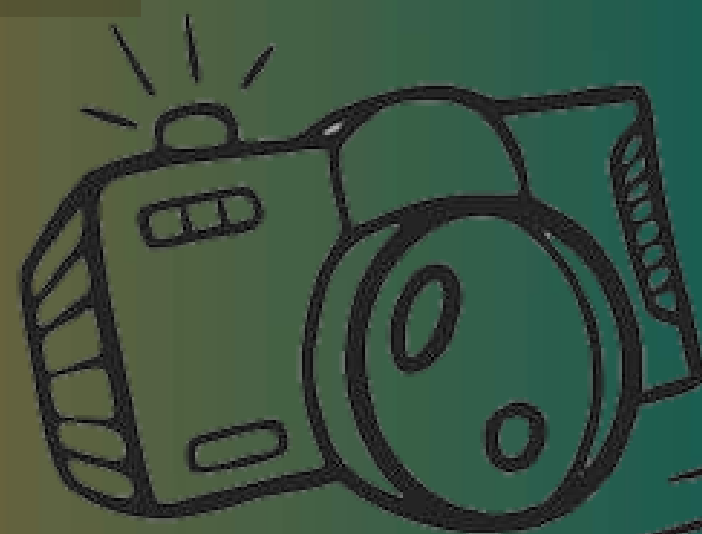
PHOTOGRAPHY SOLO EVENT

Photography can be a powerful tool for women's empowerment, capturing diverse narratives and challenging stereotypes. It provides a platform for self-expression, highlighting women's strength, resilience, unique stories and also their emotions. This event shows a photographers' skill not just as a technician but also as an artist who can capture emotions. The objective is to capture their emotions, not expressions.

Maximum: Two participants are allowed from each college

Time: Students must report at 10.00 am on 29th February 2024.

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RULES:

- The theme for both the competition and the exhibition is 'women empowerment'. Students have the option to participate in either the exhibition or the competition or both. There will be no awards or certificates for participating in the exhibition.
- Students participating in the exhibition must carry their photographs printed on A4 photo paper.
- Mobile photography is allowed.
- Plagiarism will not be entertained.
- Photographs submitted for competition must be taken any time before 28th February 2024.

RULES:

- Two participants are allowed from each college and each student can submit 2 photographs for the competition. The top three participants, selected from all the colleges, will be awarded.
- Students must carry their ID cards, maintain decorum, and abide by the security team of the University.
- Contact photography club representatives as soon as you reach the venue and stay in contact with them for further details.

SHORT FILM TEAM EVENT

Join us for a dynamic 2-day short film event! Submit your short films for qualification check, then sit back and enjoy the screening as judges crown the winning masterpiece. Bring your best work and be part of the cinematic thrill!

Number of Participants

- Maximum Participants: 4
- Minimum Participants: 3

Time: Only short films produced and completed after January 1st 2023 are eligible for submission.

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RULES:

- The short film can be based on any subject or concept.
- The total run time of the film including opening and closing credits, should strictly be a minimum of 5 minutes and a maximum of 10 minutes.
- The short films must be in HD format or higher resolution.
- It must have an aspect ratio of 16:9; entries in other formats will not be accepted.
- The short film can be in any language. However, all films must include subtitles in English.
- The short film can be shot on camera or mobile phone.
- Only short films produced and completed after January 1st 2023 are eligible for submission.
- Participants must finish the shoot and edit of the film, before submitting the final file in person on day one.
- Final and raw footage must be provided during submission for metadata verification.
- All the content used in the short film should be owned or licensed. If any copyrighted material is used, the participants must have permission. Entries with unauthorized content will be disqualified
- Registration Fee – Rs.500

INTERCOLLEGE FILM EVENT TEAM EVENT

Cine storm quiz event consisting of 3 rounds. The first round is Q&A and the second is audio visual round, the third round will be rapid fire. It will be intercollege film event.

Number of Participants: 6 groups of 4 participants each

Maximum Participants: 24 students

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RULES:

- Only 1 group to be eliminated from first and 2 groups from the second. The third round decides the results.
- In the first round participants will be asked direct questions and will receive 10 seconds to respond.
- In case the group fails to respond or answer incorrectly, the question becomes open to all the other 5 groups and the team buzzing first will take that question.
- The second round will be an audio visual round, each of the 5 groups now will get a maximum of 20s to answer each question.
- Every correct answer will earn the team 5 points and each correct pass on question will earn the team 2 additional points.
- By the third round, three teams will be eliminated and the remaining 3 will compete in a rapid fire round where each correct answer will earn the team 5 points but a -10 for each incorrect answer.

- Any pre-recorded music or instrumentals are allowed. Participating colleges must submit the same beforehand in proper order to the host college.
- Vulgar music or obscenity in dance, inappropriate costume, is strictly prohibited and if there exists any, will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Participants must strictly adhere to the time limit and the specific number of team members specified above.



RULES:

- Any kind of inflammable objects, fluid, glass or any sharp or heavy objects is not allowed on the stage. Performers have to clear the stage after every performance.
- The organizers shall not bear any responsibilities in the case of loss or damage of any prop, or any other materials brought by the performing colleges.
- The decision of the judges shall be final and binding.
- All the rules and regulations are to be followed and any violation of the same will lead to negative feedback on the marks.
- Prior registration has to be done. The payment of the registration fee should be made as per the amount intimated above.

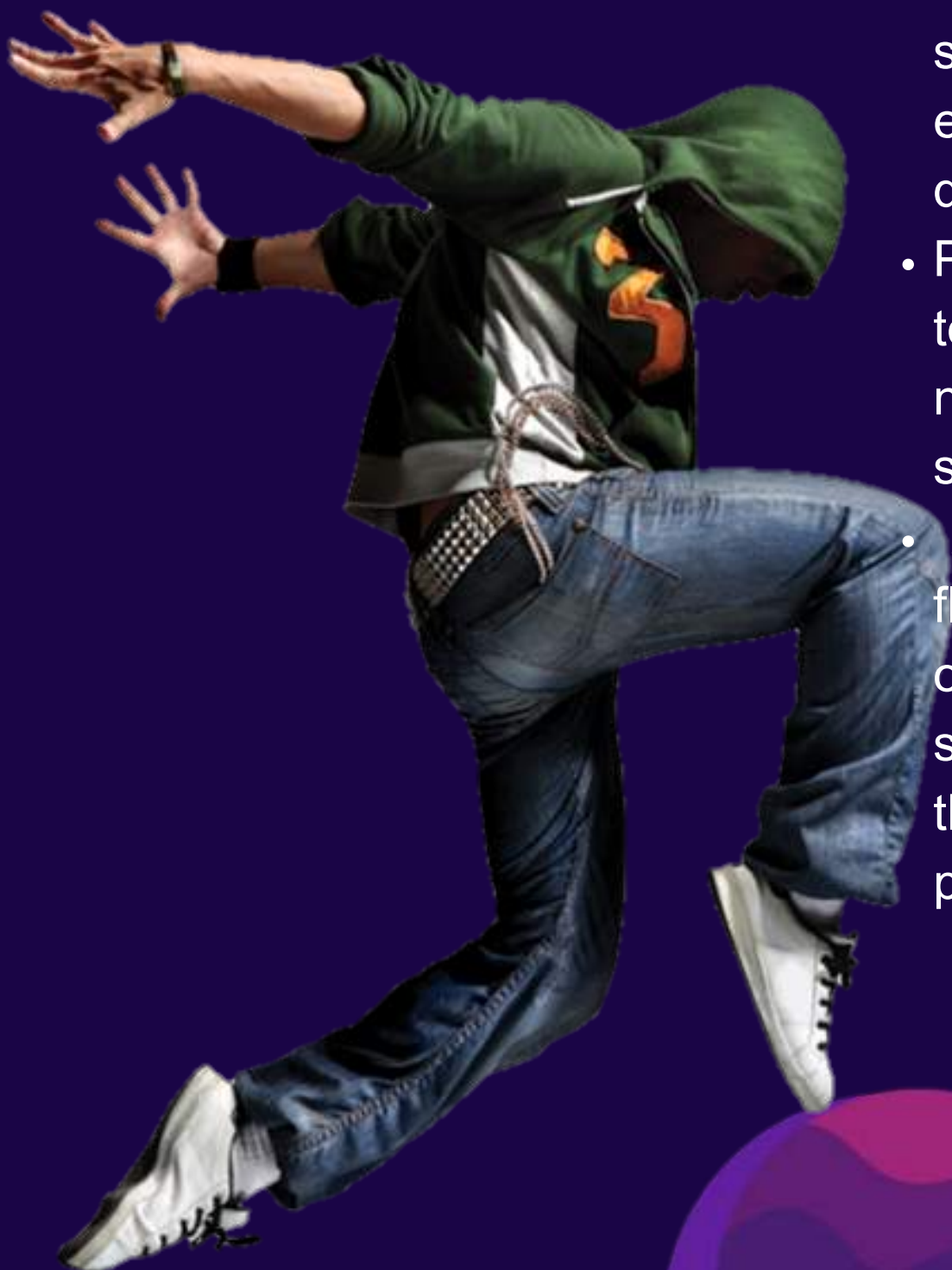

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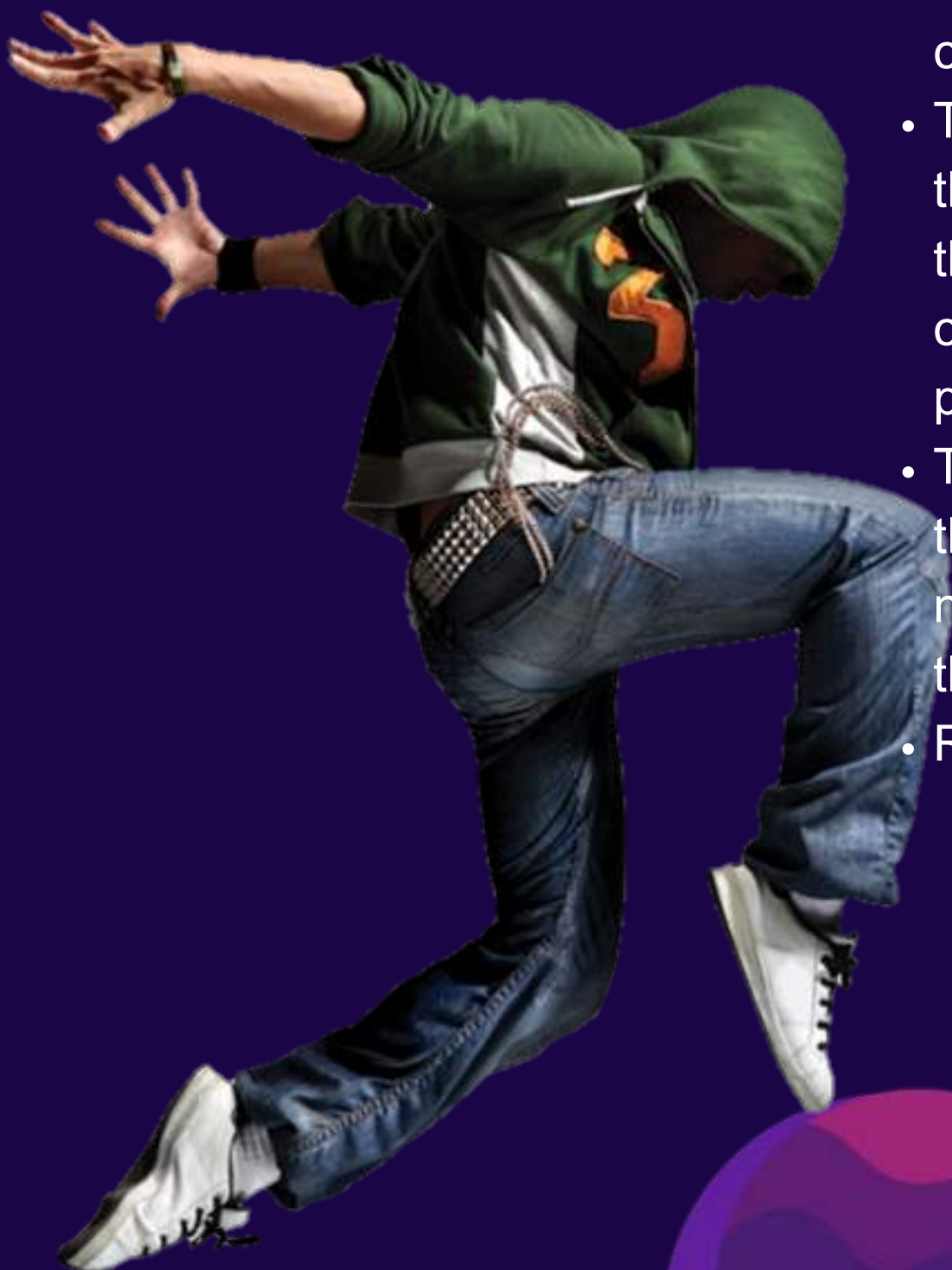
RULES:

TEAM EVENT

Maximum: 2 Teams per College

Number of Participants: Each team must consist of maximum 10 members, including the light sound and backstage managers.

Theme: The theme of the event is kept open for the participating team.

Time: A total time limit of 25 minutes per team will be allotted for their presentation (including stage setup)

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RULES:

- The script can be in English, Hindi, or Bengali.
- Prerecorded background scores are allowed but all narrations must be done live on stage.
- The prerecorded music list must be submitted to the host college beforehand.
- The host college will provide will 2 tables and 4 chairs as props for any participating college. Any extra requirement should be notified by the team with prior notice and is subject to availability of the same.
- Props must be brought by the participating college itself. No sort of liquid, glass, powdered elements, sharp or inflammable objects to be brought on stage.
- No sort of unparliamentary, derogatory or inappropriate content or any blasphemy hurting the sentiments of any political party or religion is allowed during the performance. It may lead to negative marking or even disqualification.
- The time limit must be strictly followed by the participating teams.
- The host college takes no responsibility in the loss of any valuables or props brought by the participating team.
- The team will be judged based on content, originality, acting, clarity, presentation, team coordination & time management.
- The judge's decision will be full and binding.
- Registration Fee – Rs.300
- If all the rules & regulations provided above is not followed, then the team will face straight away disqualification.

- No dance or act to be performed other than ramp walking.
- Would carry their track in a pen drive and submit in advance.

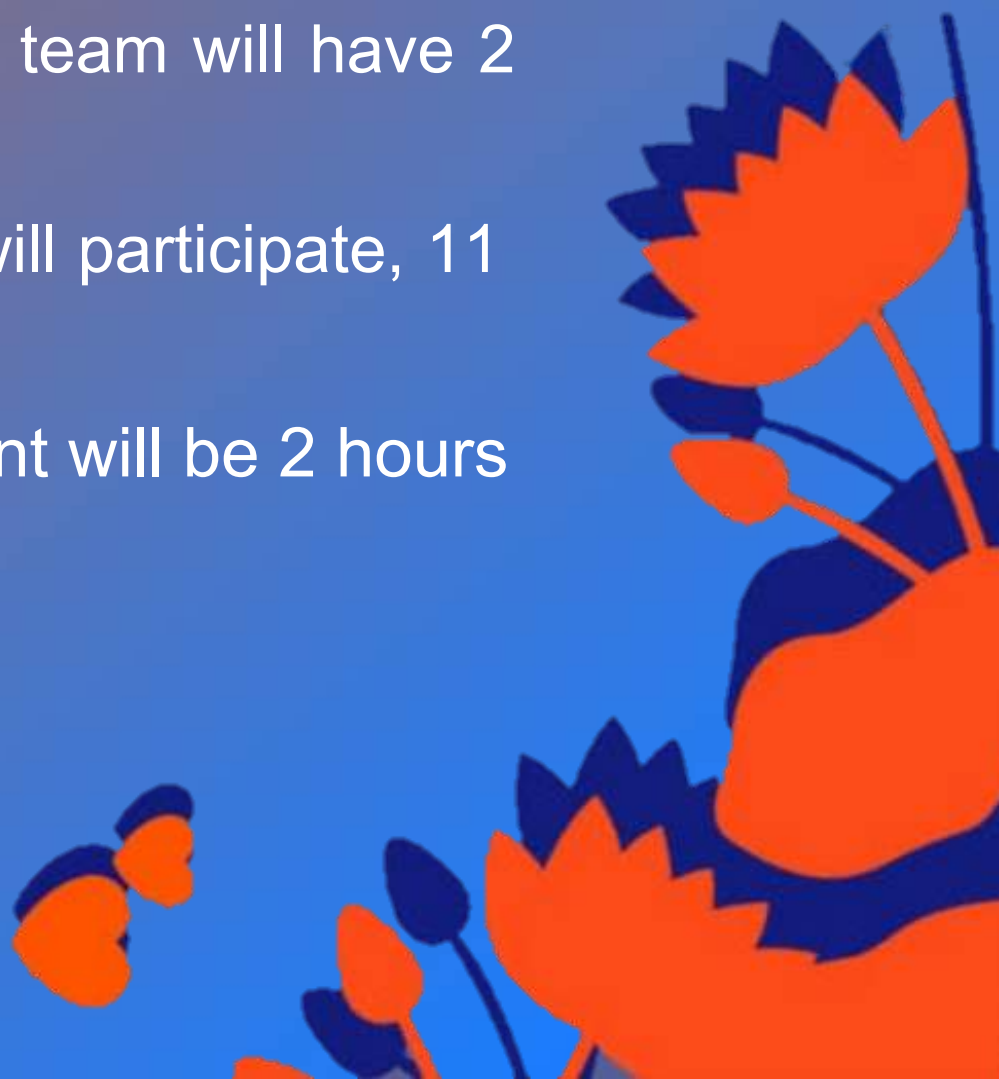
CREATIVE MAKEUP / FACE ART TEAM EVENT

- Judges will monitor form and disqualify any participant with improper form.
- In case of a tie, the participant who started the plank first wins.

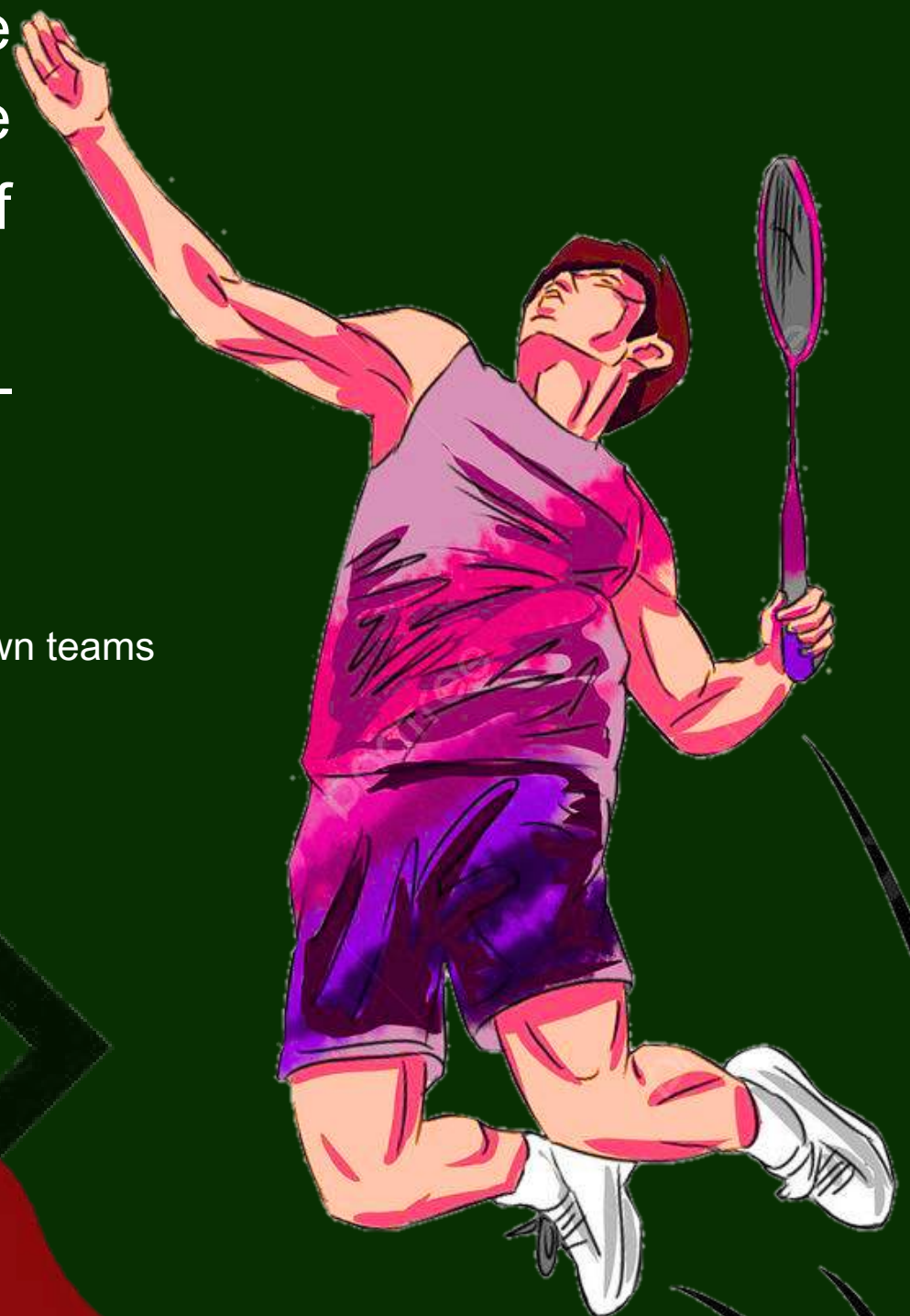

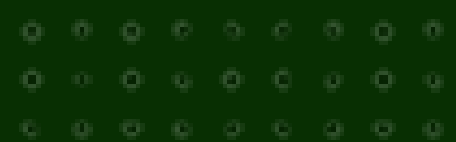

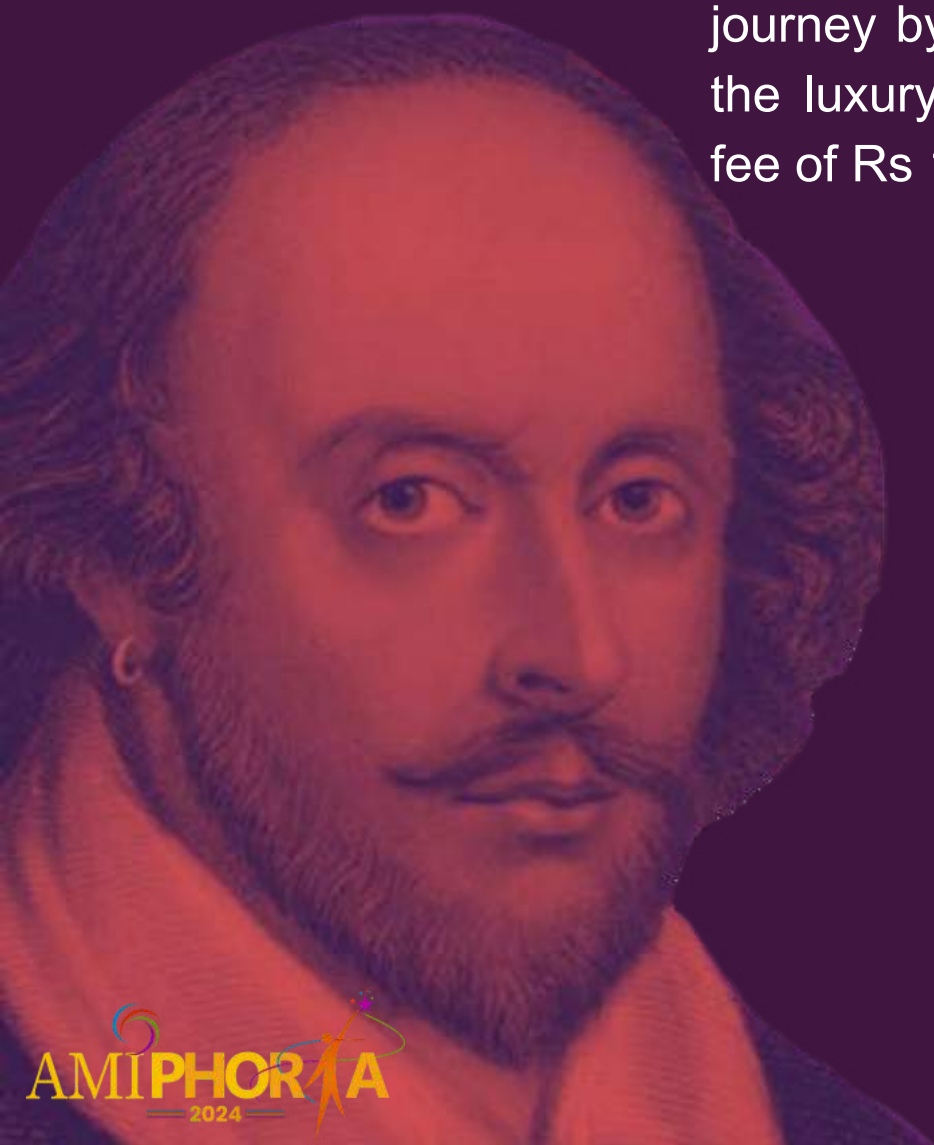

- **Personal Equipment:** Participants must bring their own controllers and keyboards. Only controllers supporting X-Input configuration are allowed. Examples include but are not limited to Xbox PC controllers, Redgear, and Cosmic Byte. The organizers will not provide any controllers or keyboards. DS4 controllers are allowed too.
- **Compatibility Check:** Players are responsible for ensuring their equipment is compatible with the gaming setup provided by the organizers. A brief period will be allocated for this purpose before the tournament starts.
- **Set-Up Time:** Each player will be given 5 minutes before their match to set up controls, choose teams, and make any necessary configurations. Assistance from the tournament staff will be available for technical difficulties.
- **Default Settings:** All matches will be played on default game settings unless specified otherwise by the organizers. Any changes to game settings must be approved by both players and the tournament referee.

Match Play

- **Match Duration:** Matches will be set to a default length of 5 minutes per half, with extra time and penalties to decide the winner in the event of a draw.

If the issue cannot be resolved within 10 minutes, the match will be restarted. If a player is found to be at fault for the disconnection, they will forfeit the match.

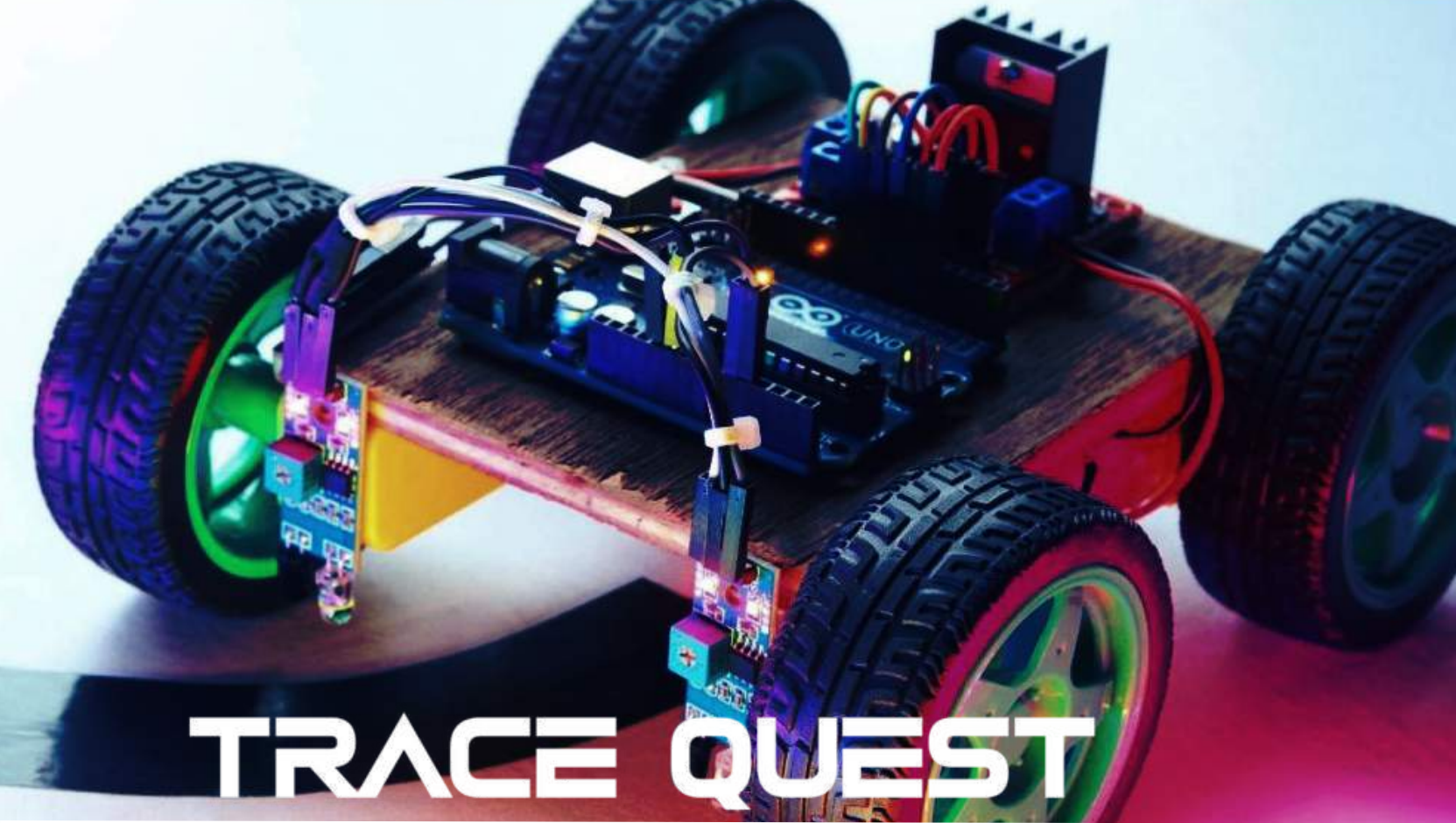

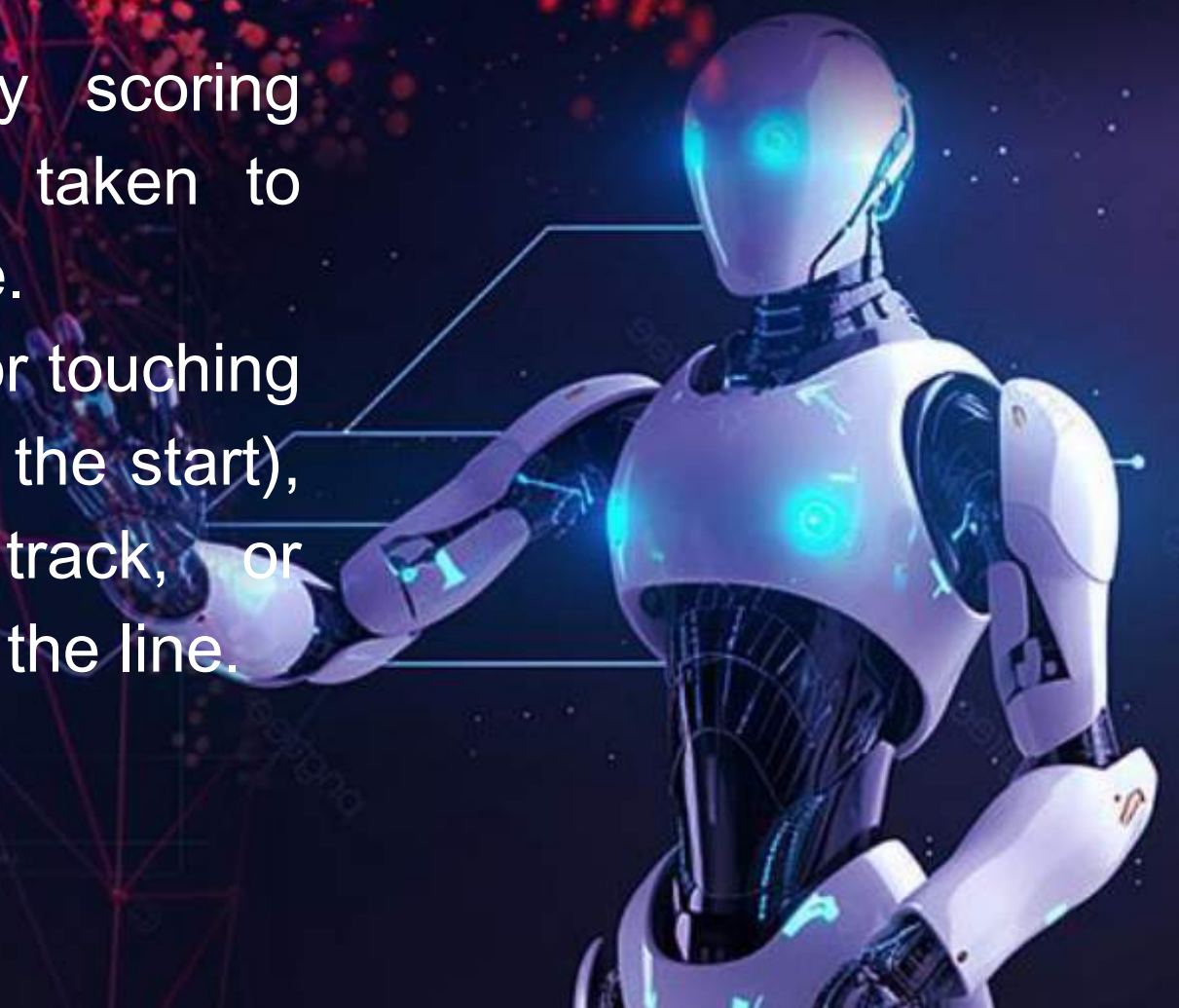
- **Dimensions:** The team must ensure that the robot must fit within a specified box (e.g., 20cm x 20cm x 20cm) at the start of the race.
- **Control:** Must be fully autonomous after starting. No remote control allowed.
- **Power:** Only electric power is allowed. Voltage and power source specifications (maximum 12V).

Track Design

- **Dimensions:** The track will be a black line (15mm width) on a white background, with a total length of 10 meters, including straight sections, curves, and potential obstacles.
- **Features:** May include crossings, gaps in the line, sharp turns, and inclines.
- **Start/Finish Line:** Clearly marked and distinguished from the rest of the track.

Scoring System

- **Time:** The primary scoring metric is the time taken to complete the course.

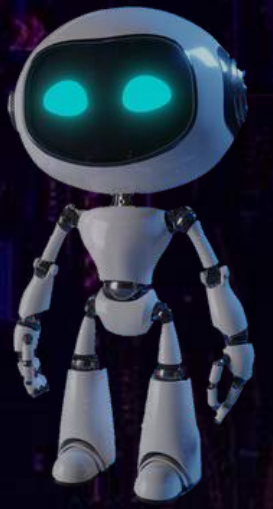

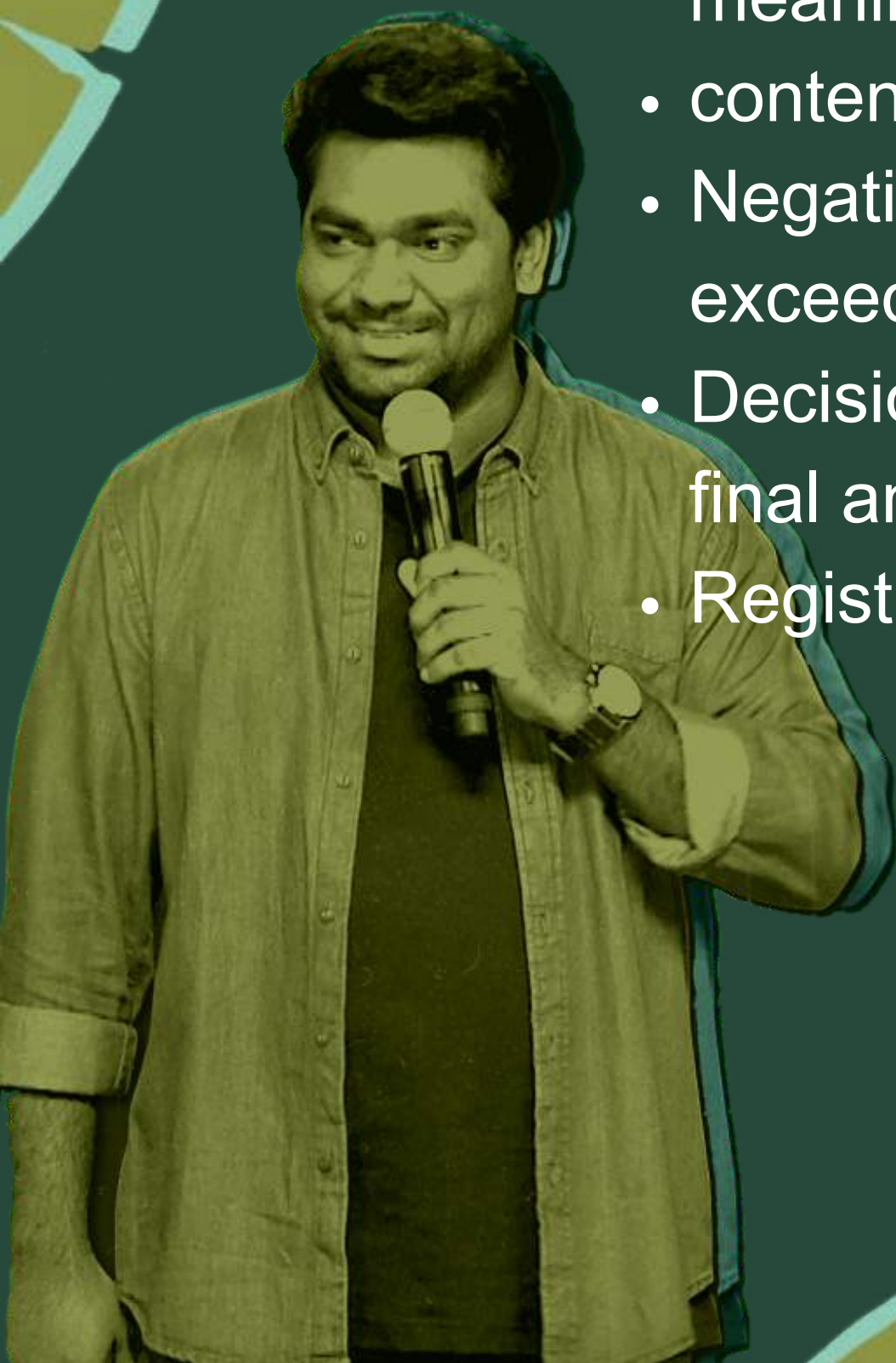
